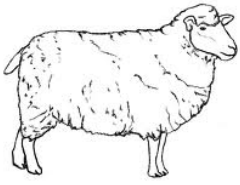

- 1 All animals must be shown on halters and have been the property of the exhibitor for at least three months prior to the Show.
- 2 All livestock must be on the Showground by 8.30 a.m. **There is no overnight accommodation for livestock.** Lorry and entry passes must be produced at the gate for admission to the ground. Straw will be provided.
- 3 Entrants should be aware of the current DEFRA regulations for animal movements. **Ear tags will be checked.**
- 4 No livestock to be removed before 4.30 p.m.
- 5 If insufficient entries are received in the Hereford classes they may be transferred to the Native Breed classes.

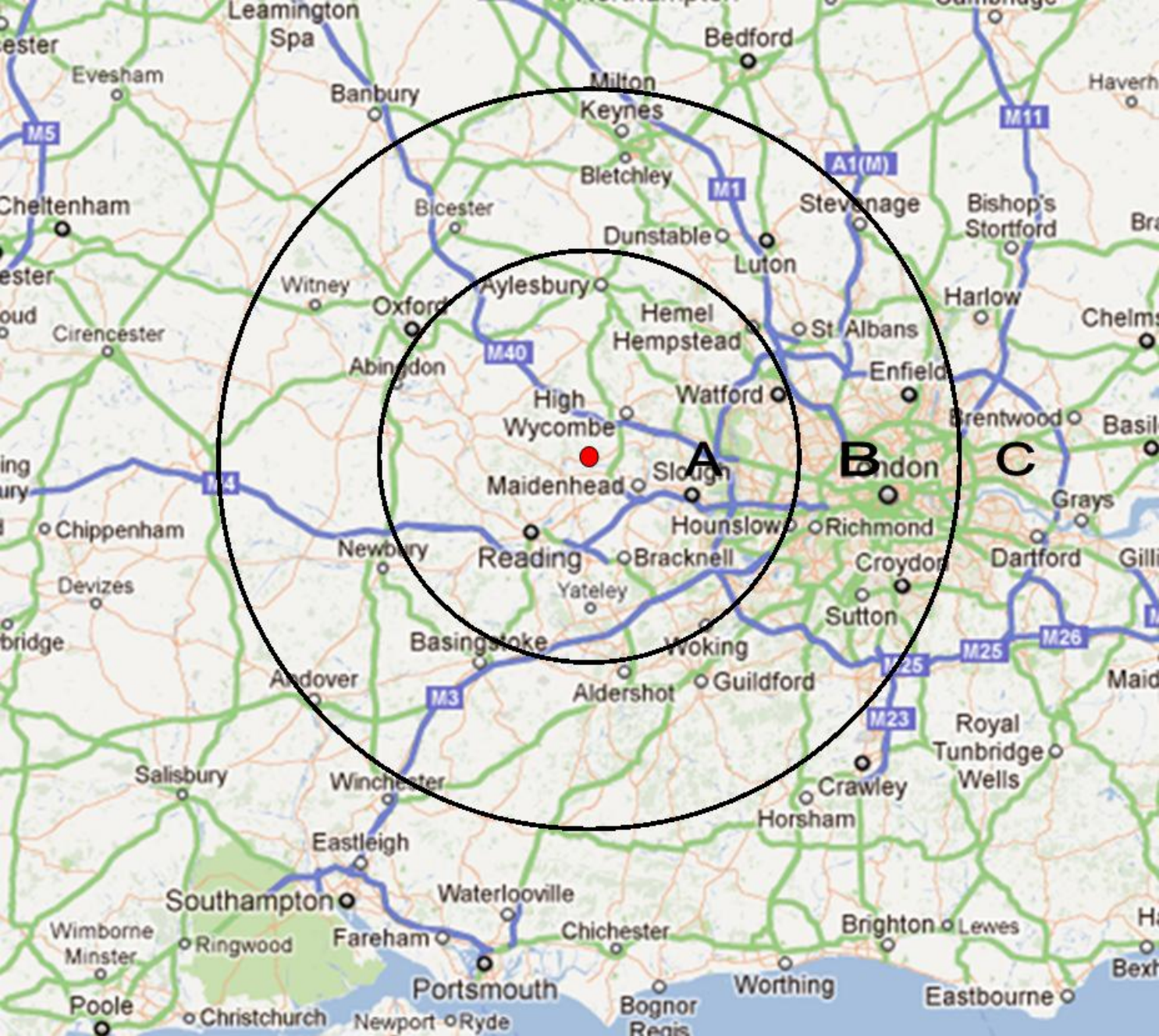
