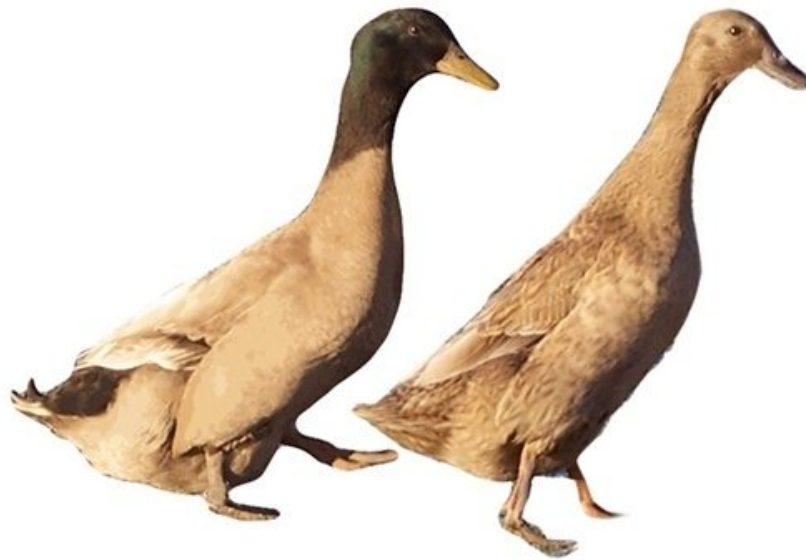

- 2 All exhibits to be the sole property of the exhibitor
- 3 No exhibit may be handled except by judges or stewards after penning
- 4 Entries close **Tuesday 10<sup>th</sup> September 2024 postmarked**  
**Entries to: Mr Richard Sear, Quill Hall Farm, Quill Hall Lane, Amersham, HP6 6LL**
- 5 No late entries accepted
- 6 Current DEFRA HEALTH REGULATIONS APPLY
- 7 Please state class number, breed and sex of bird on the entry form
- 8 The Show Committee or the Poultry Clubs will not be liable for any damage, loss or injury whilst on the Showground
- 9 The Judge's decisions are final
- 10 The Show closes at 4.00 p.m. when exhibits may be lifted
- 11 Junior Bird Classes – entrants must be aged 16 or under on the day of the Show
- 12 The section Secretary reserves the right to remove any exhibit that is not considered to be healthy.
- 13 It is the responsibility of the exhibitor or his/her representative to water and feed all of his/her exhibits **after judging** and for the welfare officer to ensure that this is carried out.
- 14 All exhibitors including non Poultry Club members agree to be bound by all such rules.
