Class 3: Implement or miscellaneous agricultural vehicle	Class 4: Best restored tractor
Class 5: Best collection of tractors (entrant with two or more tractors)	Class 6: Entry the Judge would most like to take home; <i>Optional £5 entry fee for Class 6 only prize fund</i>

A trophy will be presented for the winner of Class 1 to 5.

- When the tractor is "on show" and not attended, the battery should be disconnected (where possible) and either a "keep off tractor" sign in place or a rope/barrier in place to stop children from climbing onto it.
- The tractor must be left with the **brake on, in gear and parked so it's sideways to the hill slope**, i.e., not pointing down.
- If passengers are carried in trailers, NFU guidelines must be adhered to.
- Persons under the age of 16 years must not be left in charge of any tractor, be on the tractor or drivers lap when moving. The driver of the exhibit must not be excluded from use on the public highway, irrespective of whether the tractor is licensed or not.
- *I will agree to the terms of the invitation to the Show and comply with all Stewards and the safety policy of Henley Farm & Country Show, particularly with respect to any additional guidelines which might be in force at the showground. In the event of a dispute the Event Organiser's decision is final.*
- *I agree that for the duration of the Show any self-propelled vehicle attending the Henley Show will be the subject of a Road Traffic Act Third Party Insurance Policy as a minimum.*
- *I give consent to the Henley Show Organisers to hold my contact details on file.*
