

SHEEP CLASSES

Open to all Native Breeds (Non M.V Sheep only)

Judge: Hannah Dinmore

Judging will commence at 9.30 am so please ensure that all entrants are on the showground by 8.30 am

Class 1 Ram born in 2025 or older

Class 2 Ram lamb born in 2026

Class 3 Ewe born in 2025 or older

Class 4 Ewe lamb born in 2026

The winner of each of the above classes will go forward to the Native Breeds Championship, which will follow on directly after the completion of Class 5.

The Beenham Cup and £25 (kindly sponsored by Thame Farmers Auction Mart Ltd) will be presented to the Native Champion

Class 5 Group of Three (one entry per exhibitor)
All of the three to have been shown in the above classes, and all must be the property of the same exhibitor. One animal to be of the opposite sex, but all must be of the same breed.

The Richmond Edwards Perpetual Challenge Cup will be awarded to the winner of this class

Class 6 Wool on the Hoof
Sheep may be selected on the day but must have been shown in one of the above classes. Sheep must be shown in the wool.

COMMERCIAL CLASSES (Non M.V. Sheep only)

Class 7 Commercial Ram – any breed or cross

Class 8 Commercial Ewe – any breed or cross

Commercial Champion will be presented with a plaque kindly sponsored by Simmons & Sons

Class 9 Pen of four Butchers Lambs

Class 10 Young Handler – Aged 6 – 12.
Sponsored by Risto's Farm Supplies

Class 11 Young Handler – Aged 13 – 18
Sponsored by Risto's Farm Supplies
The exhibitors will be judged on their personal turnout and their ability to handle and show the sheep.

SHEEP ENTRY & PEN FEES

Classes 1 – 9 £5.00 per entry per class irrespective of the number of sheep brought to the show (up to a maximum of ten per exhibitor).
Pen Fees - £5.00 per pen

Classes 9 – 10 Young Handlers Free Entry

SHEEP PRIZE MONEY

Classes 1 – 11 1st - £15.00 2nd - £10.00 3rd - £5.00

There will be a prize awarded to the exhibitor whose pens are judged to be the tidiest and most informative.

1. Entrants should be aware of the current DEFRA Regulations for Animal Movements.
2. LIS-1 movement documents are required upon arrival.
3. All livestock must be on the Showground by 8.30 a.m. Livestock lorry and entry passes must be produced at the gate for admission to the ground.
4. All animals in Classes 1 – 8 & 10 - 11 must be shown on halters and be the bona-fide property of the exhibitor.
5. No livestock to be removed before 4.30 p.m.
6. Prize money will be paid irrespective of how many entries there are in a Class.
7. Cups must be collected and signed for from the Trophy Secretary in the Show Secretary's tent (next to the Members' Enclosure)
8. No Dogs by Ringside and Pens.
