Show Jumping Classes

Ring 2

9am Prompt Start

The event will be run under The Pony Club Show Jumping Rules 2026

All classes will be run on grass, single phase.

No outside assistance (verbal or signalled) except for Class 1 and Class 2.
Horses and Ponies may not be entered in more than three jumping classes.

| Class 1 | X-poles | Sponsored by The Countess of Macclesfield
May be led/assisted. Clear round rosette for all those jumping clear but not placed. Leo the Lion Trophy presented to the highest placed Woodland Hunt Member. |
| Class 2 | 40cm | Sponsored by DPI Interiors
May be led/assisted. Clear round rosette for all those jumping clear but not placed. |
| Class 3 | 50cm | Sponsored by The Phillimore Family |
| Class 4 | Pairs Relay 50/60cm | Rider 1 jumps first half of the course at 50cm,rides to the handover box.
Rider 2 completes the second half at 60cm. Fastest clear wins! |
| Class 5 | 60cm | Sponsored by The Radford-Jones Family |
| Class 6 | 70cm | Sponsored by The Palmer Arms |
| Class 7 | Pairs Relay 70/80cm | Rider 1 jumps first half of the course at 70cm,rides to the handover box.
Rider 2 completes the second half at 80cm. Fastest clear wins! |
| Class 8 | 80cm | Sponsored by The Bignell Family |
| Class 9 | Accumulator Class - Most points wins a prize!! | There will be 10 jumps ranging from 70cm-95cm. Each fence is worth the same number of points (e.g fence 1 = 1 pt). A knockdown or a refusal = 0 points. The final fence will be a joker (95cm) and will be worth 20 points. Rider with highest points wins. In the event of a tie then the fastest time will decide placings. |

Times

- A drawn order of jumping times will be published by Thursday 10th September on www.ponyclubresults.co.uk

Numbers

- Numbers for Show Jumping Classes will be available on www.ponyclubresults.co.uk which you will be required to print and wear in number bibs.

Show Ground Entry

- Light Horse Vehicle Passes will be emailed to competitors using the email address you make your booking with.
- Horsebox pass must be printed and displayed in the window of your vehicle to gain entry to the show ground.
- Only Horseboxes and vehicles towing horses are permitted entry to the show ground. Vehicles carrying spectators/grooms/tack/equipment must park in the Public Car Park.
- Horsebox pass admits occupants to the event. Please do not abuse this privilege or you will be turned away.
- Please follow the light horse parking signage and park as directed by the stewards.

Entry Fee and Medical Cover

- Entry fee of £15.00 for classes 1, 2, 3. £17.50 for classes 5, 6, 8, 9, 10, 11. £25 for classes 4 and 7. A single compulsory £5 paramedic cover fee is payable PER COMPETITOR.
- There is a non-refundable booking fee payable per class.
- Online entries only accepted. No entries on the day.
- The Judges decision is final.

Horse Show – Conditions of Entry

By entering the competition, you are agreeing to the conditions laid out in this schedule.

General

- The decision of the judges and stewards in all cases is final.
- The organisers reserve the right to refuse any entry without giving a reason.

- Classes will be run single phase.
- Combinations competing in Class 1 are not permitted to compete in Classes 3 and above.
- Being late for your time may result in elimination.

Entries and Fees

- All entries must be accompanied by the correct entry fee.
- There will be no refund of entry fees after the closing date. Refunds prior to the closing date will be given minus the booking fee.
- No substitution of entries after the closing date.
- A rider may request to substitute a horse/pony for a class that he/she has entered if the organisers are so advised and in agreement. Horse and rider may not be substituted – this is in effect a completely different entry.
- The organisers reserve the right to alter the programme of events at their discretion. Should the event be cancelled for any reason, the organisers reserve the right to retain a proportion of the entry fees to cover their expenses.

Horses and Competitors

- Horses and ponies must be 5 years or older on the day of the show.
- [All horses must be fully vaccinated against equine influenza.](#)
- Equine passports must accompany all horses to the showground. Spot checks are likely.
- All competitors must be suitably dressed in correct riding attire.
- Hats must be of the standard accepted as of 1st January 2026. See the PC Show Jumping Rule Book 2026 for a table of accepted standards. Chin straps must be correctly fastened at all times when mounted.
- All competitors must have their hats tagged with the Pony Club PINK tag and have safe, clean tack. A YELLOW spurs tag is required for anyone jumping in spurs.

- Body protectors should be BETA 2018 standard. Air jackets are not permitted.
- PADDED JUMPING BATS ONLY are permitted for the show jumping classes. Please read the whip rule carefully as this will be strictly adhered to – see the PC Show Jumping Rule Book 2026.
- Excessive use of the whip, including repeated slapping down the shoulder, is prohibited and may result in elimination.

Safety and Conduct

- The organisers have taken all reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents, and must obey the instructions of the organisers and all officials and stewards.
- In the interests of safety and the smooth running of the event, all competitors and accompanying persons must follow the instructions of show officials, including directions regarding the parking of vehicles.
- Lead ropes must be attached to the noseband or coupling only.
- Horses/ponies tied to the outside of trailers/lorries must not be left unattended.
- Dogs must be kept on leads. Please do not leave dogs in your vehicle unattended. If dogs are found to be at risk, forcible entry to your vehicle may be necessary without liability for any damage caused.
- Please ensure that the area around your box is left clean and tidy.

Objections

- Any objections must be made in writing and handed to the show secretary within 15 minutes of the incident, accompanied by a deposit of £10.00. If the objection is sustained, the deposit will be refunded.

Insurance and Photography

- All non-Pony Club competitors are not covered by The Pony Club insurance and must have their own third-party cover. The Woodland Hunt Branch of The Pony Club and the organisers of this event are not legally responsible for non-members, and their insurance will not cover you.
- Woodland Hunt PC takes the privacy and safeguarding of children at Pony Club very seriously. The only external photographers permitted to take images of children at any of our Pony Club events are those directly engaged by the organisers. These images will never be used for any external media, advertising or promotion without the express written permission of the parents.

Liability

Save for death or personal injury caused by the negligence of the organisers or anyone for whom they are in law responsible, neither the organisers of this event, The Pony Club, nor any agent, employee or representative of these bodies, nor the landlord or his tenant, accepts any liability for any accident, loss, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, spectators, land, cars, their contents and accessories, or any other personal property whatsoever, whether caused by their negligence, breach of contract or in any other way whatsoever. Entries are only accepted on this basis.
